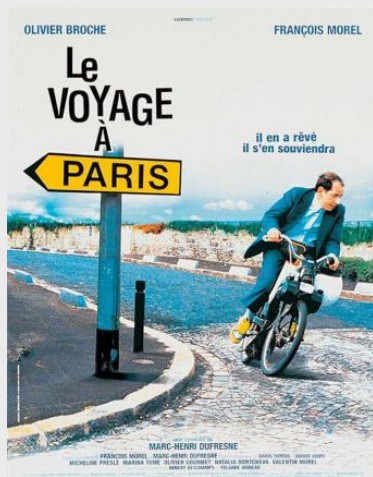


THE JOURNEY TO PARIS

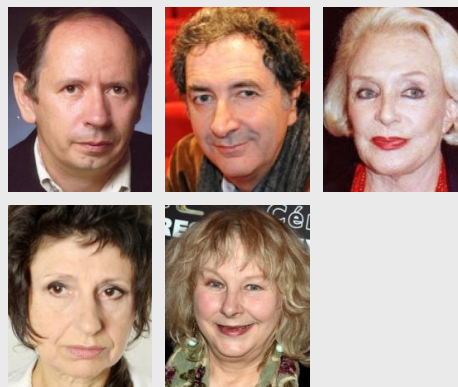
